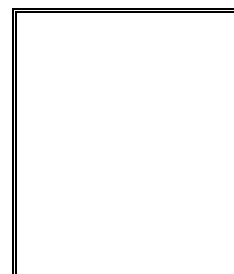

Evis Alimehmeti is a professor of law and researcher from the Faculty of Law, University of Tirana. Her academic and research profiles include public law and international human rights law. Her research extends to both civil law and common law systems. She has a Doctorate degree from the University of Tirana in the field of the law of the European Convention on Human Rights, a Master of Laws (LLM) degree from Queen's University, Kingston, Ontario, Canada and a Master of Philosophy (MPhil) degree from Open University, London UK, a joint degree with Central European University, Hungary in human rights studies. During 2009- 2016 she also served as the Head of the Public Law Department of the Faculty of Law, University of Tirana. In addition to the academic background, she has a long counselling experience on issues related to human rights and rule of law with several international organizations and foreign assistance programs; she has provided expertise for many years to the Organisation for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE), USAID Rule of Law Program for Albania, United Nation Development Program in Albania (UNDP), International Organisation for

Migration (IOM), etc.

Since 2018 she is a member of the Advisory Committee of the Framework Convention for the Protection of National Minorities of the Council of Europe and serves also as a Gender Equality Rapporteur of the Committee.
